Colonel H. Brent Baker, Sr., is the Commander, Global Logistics Support Center Provisional (GLSC)(P). The GLSC(P) stood up 7 May 2007 at Wright Patterson AFB. The GLSC will be the AF Supply Chain Management process owner for the Air Force. It will function as the Air Operations Center for supply chain management. The GLSC organization reports directly to the AFMC Commander and will perform three primary roles of supply chain management: Supply Chain Planning and Execution; Supply Chain Operations; and Supply Chain Strategy and Integration. The formal GLSC capability is scheduled to stand up officially in FY08.

Colonel Baker entered the U.S. Air Force in 1979 as an enlisted member and in 1985 was commissioned a second lieutenant through Officer Training School after graduation from Southern Illinois University. He has served as a presidential fuels flight officer and as the 18th Mission Support Group Commander, Kadena Air Base, Japan. He has had numerous assignments at base-level supply and headquarters staff positions. He is a fully qualified joint specialty officer. Before assuming his current position, Colonel Baker served as Commander, 95th Air Base Wing, Edwards AFB, CA.
