The Dayton-Wright Chapter of the Armed Forces Communications and Electronics Association (AFCEA) will hold its annual tradeshow and conference, TechNet-Aero 2011 at the Dayton Convention Center, 17-20 October 2011. The theme this year is "Discover -- Innovate -- Realize." Presentations and seminars will focus on capabilities to employ aerospace dominance to achieve our national interests. Our Industry partners are developing innovations that will enable significant gains in all aspects of our missions. These innovations are foundational to strengthening excellence in supporting the nuclear enterprise, improving Integrated Life Cycle Management processes supporting the warfighters, implementing the Acquisition Improvement Plan, and conserving energy and resources under AFMC control.
